Volunteers are the foundation of our after school programs. We offer over 150 sessions per school year and volunteers are the key to a successful experience for young people. Volunteers really enjoy the time they spend with youth too!

You will receive an email or phone call confirming receipt of your volunteer registration. Be sure to indicate on the form if there are supplies you need us to provide. Please arrive 15 minutes before your volunteer session. This allows you to set up, check your classroom/volunteer area and be prepared for youth who will be very excited to see you!

The time you will spend with youth is as listed:

Rush City (Mondays): 3:45- 4:40

North Branch (Tuesdays): 4:15 – 5:10

Braham (Wednesdays): 4:00 – 5:00

Taylor Falls (Thursdays): 4:00 – 4:55

Lakeside (Fridays): 4:00 – 4:55

Volunteers are expected to:

- Be on time;
- Notify Community Partnership no later than noon (651-674-4085) if you are unable to volunteer on a day that you signed up;
- Stay until the designated end time;
- Notify the site coordinator if there are student behavior problems;
- Be a positive influence;
- Help students make new friends;
- Reinforce the anti-drug messages;
- Be respectful of teacher's classrooms – please leave it in the same, clean condition it was in when you started your session;
- Encourage your friends, co-workers, and others to volunteer.

NOTE: We will be conducting routine volunteer background checks this year, per our funding mandates.
